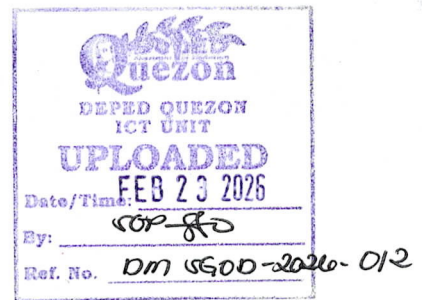

SUBJECT : 2026 COUNCIL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. The Quezon Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the holding of another historic council event, the **2026 COUNCIL SCOUT JAMBOREE** on **08 – 11 April 2026** at **Lopez National Comprehensive High School, Lopez, Quezon**, with the **Theme: "SAFE & PROTECTED"**.
2. **Background:** This year's most awaited council event happens again after a decade and is expecting to host more than 2,000 Scouts and Scout Leaders over the province with some special guests, and participation from other councils.

Scouting is an educational youth Movement that builds friendships, experiences, and skills for life, shaping young people's future as active citizens. Today, Scouting is the world's leading educational youth movement worldwide. Through its unique combination of education, adventure and fun, Scouting continues to be inspiration for young people to become active citizens who are engaged in creating a better and more sustainable world.

A Scout Jamboree is the "**Mother of all Activities**" of a Scout's life, something every dedicated Scout and even Scout Leaders look forward to and whose memories are cherished deeply afterward. In a Jamboree, Scouts expand their hearts and minds learning new things and discovering rich assortment of novel experiences. Such a gathering requires all the basic services provided by a municipality – shelter, water, market, hospital, fire department, toilets and showers, garbage collection and disposal, etc. With the exception of a prison!

3. **Rationale.** Through the years, Quezon Council, BSP has played and continues to play a primordial role in the community and society as a youth organization that encourages and helps young people develop their individual potentials and capabilities and raise their level of awareness and importance of their responsibilities for social development.

Jamboree is learning by doing. Scouting's approach to education is a guided by the principles and fundamentals beliefs on which Scouting was founded over a century ago. It aims to continues to the empowerment of individuals and their development as active citizens in their communities. Guiding this process is a diverse set of competencies in the Scout Youth Programme that focus on knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values.

4. Jamboree Aim and Objectives.

The 2026 Council Scout Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their full Social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional and Spiritual potentials as an active citizen making real contribution in creating a better community.

At the end of the Jamboree, the participants should be able to:

- Promote Scouting's highest quality standards of educational initiatives that is faithful to the vision, mission, fundamental principles and methods of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
- Undertake high-adventure and outdoor activities that promotes active and healthy lifestyle and appreciation of nature and environment;
- Complete and satisfy the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout Ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System; *and*
- Increasing the level of awareness and understanding about the prevailing issues on environment, human rights, protections and Cross Roads of Cultures.

5. Qualification for Participation. The following are the qualifications for all participating Scouts and Scout Leaders:

a. Boy Scout and Senior Scout

- Must be currently registered as Boy/Senior Scout;
- Physically fit to undergo strenuous activities especially in the outdoors as certified by a licensed Physician;
- Must be at least thirteen (13) to eighteen (18) years old for Senior Scouts;
- Secure his/her Parent's/Guardian's Consent; *and*
- Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment.

b. Troop Leader and Outfit Advisor

- Must be of good moral character;
- Must be currently registered as Troop Leader or Outfit Advisor;
- Must be Physically Fit as certified by a licensed Physician;
- Preferably graduate of the Basic Training Course; *and*
- Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment.

6. Registration Details. Stated below are the important details regarding the Jamboree Registration Procedure, viz:

a. **Registration Fee.** Jamboree Registration Fee of **SIX HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (PhP 600.00)** shall be charged from each participant to cover administrative and operational cost and defray expenses for the souvenirs: CSJ neckerchief, patch, ID, lanyard and certificate.

b. **Pre-Registration and Deadlines.** A non-refundable but transferrable **Reservation Deposit of Three Hundred Pesos (PhP 300.00)** must be paid to the council on or before **Monday, March 16, 2026**. The remaining balance must be settled not later than **Tuesday, 07 April 2026**.

8. **Jamboree Theme Song/Jingle Dance Interpretation.** The Jamboree Organizing Committee, will release an official memorandum to encourage creative Scouts and Scout Leaders to share their ideas and participate in the contest for the Theme Song/Jingle Dance Interpretations.
9. **Jambo Balita / "Ang Pamaytinta".** Jamboree Organizing Committee, through the Jambo Balita will be publishing and releasing bulletins from time to time in order to provide everyone with the latest information and details about the Jamboree, allowing and enabling all participants to adequately prepare for the event.
