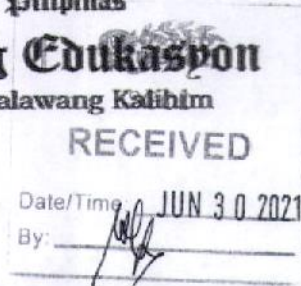

(CPR)-READY PHILIPPINES CAMPAIGN**


