Committed to integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights in the provision and governance of basic education, agencies are required to develop and maintain a Gender and Development (GAD) database containing gender statistics and sex-disaggregated data to serve as bases for gender analysis, planning, programming and policy formulation.




