- Awarding of fun recognitions (e.g., most colorful participant, best group spirit)
Method Applied: Experiential Learning, Active Participation
Objective Supported: Promotes appreciation of diversity and shared community engagement
- B. Midday Session: Learning and Awareness
 1. Symposium on Gender and Social Inclusion in the Workplace
 2. Open Forum / Q&A
 - Participants engage with the speaker for clarification and discussion
Method Applied: Interactive Learning, Guided Discussion
Objective Supported: Enhances knowledge and awareness of LGBTQIA+ concepts and rights
- C. Afternoon Session: Reflection and Commitment
 1. Commitment Setting Activity
 - Guided reflection (individual or group-based)
 - Writing of personal or collective commitments on inclusivity and respect
 - Posting of commitments on a “Pride Wall” or Commitment Board
 2. Solidarity Activity
 - Group pledge or affirmation of support for inclusivity and non-discrimination
Method Applied: Reflective Practice, Values Formation
Objective Supported: Encourages adoption of inclusive behaviors and personal accountability

 1. Synthesis of Learning
 - Key takeaways from the day’s activities
 2. Closing Remarks
