In reference to DepEd Task Force COVID-19 MEMORANDUM No. 39, s. 2020 entitled "Strict Enforcement of Tobacco Control Policies, including Smoke-Free and Vape-Free Policies, During the Enhanced and General Community Quarantine". All national government specifically the Department of Education are enjoined to ensure the strict enforcement of tobacco control policies that govern DepEd (Annex A), which includes the following:

- 1. Prohibit smoking and the use of Electronic Nicotine and NonNicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS/ENNDS) - commonly known as vape or e-cigarette - within the premises of all DepEd schools and offices:
- 2. Order schools through their respective Child Protection Committees, in coordination with their respective LGUs, to ensure that no tobacco products and ENDS/ENNDS are sold within 100 meters from any point of the perimeter of the school; and
- 3. Warn against unnecessary interaction with the tobacco industry, including the prohibition on sponsorships by tobacco companies and other organizations that receive funds from tobacco companies.

Relevant to this, DepEd Quezon through the SGOD-School Health Section will host a webinar entitled "Strengthening Comprehensive Tobacco Control Program In and Around Schools and DepEd Offices during COVID-19 Pandemic " to all SDO personnel and District Health Coordinators. This activity aims to cultivate a healthy environment in and around schools and DepEd offices during COVID-19 Pandemic.
